RESOLUTION APPROVING AND AUTHORIZING EXECUTION OF A GRANT AGREEMENT WITH CREATIVE CORRIDORS COALITION TO SUPPORT THE CONSTRUCTION OF ARTS FACILITIES TO ENHANCE CERTAIN BRIDGES IN FORSYTH COUNTY PURSUANT TO THE PROVISIONS OF N.C.G.S. 160A-488

WHEREAS, N.C.G.S. 160A-488 authorizes counties to support, contract with, and appropriate funds to nonprofit corporations to support arts facilities, and sculpture as part of a visual arts program; and

WHEREAS, Creative Corridors Coalition is a nonprofit corporation which has created a program responsible for funding the design and installation of architectural and artistic facilities to enhance certain bridges in Forsyth County; and

WHEREAS, Creative Corridors requests that Forsyth County provide financial support of the arts facilities to enhance certain bridges in Forsyth County;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Forsyth County Board of Commissioners hereby approves a grant agreement with Creative Corridors Coalition to support the construction of arts facilities to enhance certain bridges in Forsyth County in the amount of \$150,000.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Forsyth County Board of Commissioners hereby authorizes the Chairman or the County Manager and the Clerk to the Board to execute, on behalf of Forsyth County, a grant agreement with Creative Corridors Coalition in the amount of \$150,000 to support arts facilities to enhance certain bridges in Forsyth County, subject to a preaudit certificate thereon by the County Chief Financial Officer and approval as to form and legality by the County Attorney.
