SUMMARY OF INFORMATION:		
The Forsyth County Department of Public Health requests authorization to apply to the Kate B. Reynolds (KBR) Charitable Trust for a grant for a minimum of \$380,175 to support the continued operation of the School Sealant Project implemented by the Cleveland Avenue Dental Center and the Winston Salem/Forsyth County School System. The School Sealant Project began from a KBR Operating Grant awarded to the Dental Center in 2014.		
The grant would fund staff salaries and fringe benefits for time spent on the project, dental equipment and supplies, educational material, and Project Giveaway Bags for each child that participates. Staff will go into a minimum of 4 Title I Elementary Schools each year to offer dental screening, cleaning and sealant placement for children identified with the need. In school treatment will be available to any child that returns a signed parental consent form.
