RESOLUTION REQUESTING STATE FINANCIAL ASSISTANCE TO COMPLY WITH NEW CLASSROOM SIZE REQUIREMENTS

WHEREAS, in 2016, the North Carolina General Assembly enacted legislation requiring kindergarten through third grade classes to be reduced from twenty (20) to eighteen (18) students per class; and

WHEREAS, to comply with the requirements, Winston Salem/Forsyth County Schools would need to hire one hundred (100) new teachers and build three hundred (300) additional classrooms, which could cost between \$10-20 million dollars; and

WHEREAS, the Winston Salem/Forsyth County Schools System does not plan to eliminate art, music or physical education, but it does plan to eliminate computer labs to address the requirement in part;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Forsyth County Board of Commissioners hereby requests the State of North Carolina provide financial assistance to comply with the new classroom size requirements.
