## RESOLUTION APPROVING PURCHASE OF LAW ENFORCEMENT BODY WORN CAMERAS UNDER AN EXCEPTION TO THE BIDDING LAWS CODIFIED IN N.C.G.S. 143-129(e)(6) AND AWARDING A CONTRACT TO AXON ENTERPRISE, INC. (FORSYTH COUNTY SHERIFF'S OFFICE)

WHEREAS the Forsyth County Sheriff's Office needs to purchase additional law enforcement bodyworn cameras and Axon Enterprises Inc. is the sole distributor of the Axon camera systems and evidence.com data storage solution;

WHEREAS the Forsyth County Sheriff's currently uses the Axon camera systems and evidence.com data storage solution for body-worn cameras and in the suspect interrogation room;

WHEREAS N.C.G.S. 143-129(e)(6) provides that procedures for letting of public contracts do not apply to purchases of apparatus, supplies, materials, or equipment when: (i) performance or price competition for a product are not available; (ii) a needed product is available from only one source of supply; or (iii) standardization or compatibility is the overriding consideration;

WHEREAS N.C.G.S. 143-129(e)(6) further requires the governing board to approve purchases under the above provisions prior to the award of the contract;

WHEREAS Axon Enterprises Inc., has submitted a quote for sixteen (16) law enforcement cameras, data storage, service/maintenance and licensing at \$47,288.12, including tax;

WHEREAS it is the recommendation of the County Manager, the Sheriff, and the Purchasing Director that the purchase of sixteen (16) law enforcement cameras with Axon Enterprises, Inc., in the amount of \$47,288.12, be awarded to Axon Enterprises, Inc.; and

WHEREAS the County Chief Financial Officer has determined that sufficient funds are available to cover the cost of this purchase;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the Forsyth County Board of Commissioners hereby awards a contract to Axon Enterprises, Inc., in the amount of \$47,288.12, for the purchase of sixteen (16) law enforcement cameras, data storage, service/maintenance and licensing for use by the Forsyth County Sheriff's Office, under the exception to the bidding laws as provided and authorized by N.C.G.S. 143-129(e)(6); and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the County Manager and Clerk to the Board are hereby authorized to execute, on behalf of Forsyth County, a contract with Axon Enterprises, Inc., for the purchase of sixteen (16) law enforcement cameras, data storage, service/maintenance and licensing in the amount of \$47,288.12, subject to a pre-audit certificate thereon by the County Chief Financial Officer, where applicable, and approval as to form and legality by the County Attorney.
