# FORSYTH COUNTY, NORTH CAROLINA AMENDMENT TO FY 2019-2020 BUDGET ORDINANCE

FROM: BUDGET & MANAGEMENT MEETING DATE: September 12, 2019

#### **EXPLANATION:**

NC Cooperative Extension received a two-year grant from Kate B. Reynolds for \$76,692 in FY 2017-2018 for the implementation and support of a two-year youth urban gardening internship program. At the close of FY19, \$51,060 remained unspent and rolled into fund balance.

The FY20 Adopted Budget anticipated that there would be funds remaining and budgeted \$40,068 in revenue and expenditures. This item is necessary to appropriate \$10,992 that rolled into fund balance at the close of FY19 in order to reflect the full remaining grant amount so that Cooperative Extension can spend the remaining funds and close this grant.
