EXPLANATION:

Forsyth County has received additional \$138,393 from the North Carolina Department of Public Safety, Division of Adult Corrections and Juvenile Justice, Juvenile Community Programs section as expansion funding related to the implementation of Raise the Age.

JUVENILE CRIME PREVENTION COUNCIL Allocation Committee 2019-2020 Funding Recommendations

Attached is a listing of programs that requested funds for fiscal year 2019-2020 from the Juvenile Crime Prevention Council for the Raise the Age expansion funding. The amount of expansion funds available to allocate is \$138,393 for programs serving at-risk youth.

The Committee met on December 2, 2019, and received \$138,393 in requests representing five agencies for eight programs. \$25,000 was allocated to pay a portion of a comprehensive gang assessment for Forsyth County. These funds will be held in budget reserve until needed. As a result of the completion of the JCPC Allocation Process, we submit the following recommendations.
