EXPLANATION:

Forsyth County has received additional \$138,393 from the North Carolina Department of Public Safety, Division of Adult Corrections and Juvenile Justice, Juvenile Community Programs section as expansion funding related to the implementation of Raise the Age.

On December 2, 2019, the Forsyth County Juvenile Crime Prevention Council (JCPC) approved a recommended allocation budget for the \$113,393 of pass-through dollars to five agencies for eight programs. The remaining \$25,000 is recommended to be allocated as a portion of payment for a comprehensive gang assessment for Forsyth County.

JUVENILE CRIME PREVENTION COUNCIL Allocation Committee 2019-2020 Funding Recommendations

Attached is a listing of programs that requested funds for fiscal year 2019-2020 from the Juvenile Crime Prevention Council for the Raise the Age expansion funding. The amount of expansion funds available to allocate is \$138,393 for programs serving at-risk youth.
