WHEREAS on August 6, 2020, the Forsyth County Board of Commissioners approved an amendment to the Fiscal Year 2021 Budget Ordinance to appropriate \$229,757.98 which Forsyth County received from the CARES Act Provider Relief Fund;

WHEREAS Forsyth County Emergency Services Department wishes to purchase four LUCAS Chest Compression System devices, which would help with providing high-quality and safer chest compressions in situations such as patient movement and transportation during prolonged resuscitation attempts;

WHEREAS N.C.G.S. 143-129(e)(6) provides that formal bid procedures shall not apply to purchases of apparatus, supplies, materials, or equipment when performance or price competition for a product are not available, when a needed product is available from only one source of supply, or when standardization or compatibility is the overriding consideration;

WHEREAS Stryker Sales Corporation is the sole-source provider of the LUCAS Chest Compression System in the Hospital (hospitals and hospital-owned facilities), Emergency Response Services and Emergency Response Training (paramedics, professional and volunteer fire) markets in the United States; and

**WHEREAS** Forsyth County Emergency Services Department wishes to enter into an agreement with Stryker Sales Corporation for the purchase of four LUCAS Chest Compression System devices an amount not to exceed \$76,540.32;
