RESOLUTION PRESCRIBING THE BOUNDARIES OF THE SIX (6) MILE FIRE INSURANCE DISTRICTS OF FORSYTH COUNTY FOR INSURANCE GRADING PURPOSES (EMERGENCY SERVICES DEPARTMENT)

WHEREAS, N.C.G.S. 153A-233 authorizes counties to designate fire districts or parts of existing districts and prescribe the boundaries thereof for insurance grading purposes; and

WHEREAS, the North Carolina Department of Insurance requires current mapping of fire insurance districts in order for property owners to be assigned the proper district and receive credit for rated service; and

WHEREAS, present descriptions of fire districts are based upon hand drawn maps of the 1950's and 1960's when the North Carolina Department of Insurance limited districts to four (4) road miles for insurance rating purposes; and

WHEREAS, North Carolina Department of Insurance now recognizes rated protection for up to six (6) road miles from the district fire station; and

WHEREAS, new roads, population expansion, and commercial and residential development have extended beyond the original four (4) mile fire districts; and

WHEREAS, the Forsyth County Emergency Services Department has worked with the Tax Office, the Forsyth County Fire Marshal's Office, and the North Carolina Department of Insurance to revise and update the fire insurance district boundaries and maps of the eighteen fire insurance districts of Forsyth County utilizing new computer generated GIS mapping technology, which will allow property owners to receive the proper insurance grade and credit for up to six (6) road miles from the district fire station and the benefit of lower insurance rates; and

WHEREAS, these revised maps have been reviewed by the District Fire Chiefs, Forsyth County Fire Marshal's Office and the North Carolina Department of Insurance.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Forsyth County Board of Commissioners hereby prescribes the boundaries of the six (6) mile fire insurance districts of Forsyth County for insurance grading purposes, as listed on Attachment A and shown on the attached maps, which are incorporated herein by reference as previously approved by the North Carolina Department of Insurance, pursuant to the provisions of North Carolina General Statutes, Section 153A-233.
