RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING PUBLICATION OF AN OFFER TO PURCHASE COUNTY OWNED REAL PROPERTY BY NEGOTIATED OFFER, ADVERTISEMENT, AND UPSET BIDS PROCEDURE (444 WEST 25th STREET)

WHEREAS, as a result of a property tax foreclosure proceeding, Forsyth County currently owns property located at 444 West 25th Street, Winston-Salem, N.C. and further identified as Tax Block 1446, Lot 052, PIN: 6826-95-5405.00, for which the County has no use and wishes to sell to the highest bidder; and

WHEREAS, Forsyth County has received and proposes to accept an offer in the amount of Two Thousand and 00/100 Dollars (\$2,000.00) made by Mr. Kenneth David Yontz to purchase the above described real property, subject to advertisement and increased/upset bids; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to the provisions of N.C.G.S. 160A-269, Forsyth County must require the offerors to deposit five percent (5%) of their bid with the Clerk to the Board and the County is required to publish a notice of the offer for increased/upset bids; and

WHEREAS, based on the past experience of bidders failing to follow through with the purchase of the property, the Forsyth County Attorney recommends that the Forsyth County Board of Commissioners make the required five percent (5%) deposit a nonrefundable payment to offset the expense of the required advertisement of the offer in the event the bidder's offer is ultimately accepted by the Board of Commissioners and the bidder fails to follow through with the purchase through no fault of the County;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Forsyth County Board of Commissioners that pursuant to the provisions of N.C.G.S. 153A-176 and 160A-269, Forsyth County plans to sell the above described real property by negotiated offer, advertisement, and upset bids procedure and has received an offer as described above and the Board proposes to accept the said offer or any valid increased/upset bid received as provided by law, and to sell the property to the highest bidder.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Clerk to the Board is hereby authorized and required to collect a deposit of five percent (5%) of the bid amount of Kenneth David Yontz and any subsequent increased/upset bid under the applicable statute, which deposit shall be nonrefundable in the event the bidder's offer is ultimately accepted by the Board of Commissioners and the bidder fails to follow through with the purchase of the property through no fault of the County.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the County Manager is hereby authorized to publish a notice of the said offer as required by N.C.G.S. 160A-269 and to re-advertise the offer at any increased/upset bid received until no further qualifying increased/upset bids are received, at which time the Board of Commissioners may accept the final offer and sell the property to the highest bidder.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that Forsyth County may at any time reject any and all offers.
