RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING EXECUTION OF AN AMENDMENT TO A CONTRACT BETWEEN FORSYTH COUNTY AND TRICARE, P.A. FOR PSYCHOLOGICAL SERVICES AS ORDERED BY THE COURT AND REQUESTED BY THE DEPARTMENT OF SOCIAL SERVICES FOR CASE PLANNING AND SERVICES DELIVERY (DEPARTMENT OF SOCIAL SERVICES)

BE IT RESOLVED by the Forsyth County Board of Commissioners that the Chairman or County Manager and Clerk to the Board are hereby authorized to execute, on behalf of Forsyth County, the attached contract amendment between Forsyth County and TriCare, P.A. in the amount of \$60,000 for psychological services as ordered by the Court and requested by the Department of Social Services for case planning and services delivery, subject to a pre-audit certificate thereon by the Chief Financial Officer, where applicable, and approval as to form and legality by the County Attorney. The original contract is incorporated herein by reference.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the County Manager is hereby authorized to execute, on behalf of Forsyth County, subsequent contracts or contract amendments with this provider for these services within budgeted appropriations in current and future fiscal years if these services are necessary.

AMENDMENT NUMBER THREE TO CONTRACT #2014-150

NORTH CAROLINA

FORSYTH COUNTY

The original contract which is made and entered into by and between Forsyth County (the County), on behalf of its Department of Social Services (FCDSS) and TRICARE, P.A., (the Provider) for non-Medicaid recipient referrals receiving psychological and related services of the Provider as ordered by the Forsyth County District Court (the Court) and as requested by FCDSS for the purposes of FCDSS case planning and services delivery, that is dated July 1, 2013, that was amended on January 18, 2014, and March 18, 2014, is hereby further amended as follows:

Reference Section IV:

As full compensation for the Provider's services to non-Medicaid recipient referrals, the County agrees to pay the Provider as follows:

- o for psychological testing services, clinical evaluation and assessment services, case record review services and report writing services:
 - o that are provided by a qualified, licensed Psychologist who is bi-lingual and who can fluently and effectively communicate in both English and Spanish and who provides specified services to Spanish-speaking individuals who are not fluent in English, the County agrees to pay a rate not to exceed \$110 per hour
 - that are provided by a qualified, licensed Psychologist who provides specified services to Englishspeaking individuals, the County agrees to pay a rate not to exceed \$100 per hour
- o for Court testimony services, the County agrees to pay a rate not to exceed \$250 per hour all payable in monthly installments.

The County shall make payment within 30 days of receipt of an invoice and supporting documents, provided that all elements of the Agreement are satisfactorily met. Total payments under this contract are not to exceed \$60,000 during fiscal year ending June 30, 2014 without executing a written contract amendment.

This contract consists of \$30,000 in Federal funds (CFDA-Cost Allocated), \$0.00 in State funds, and \$30,000 in County funds. SIS Code 230

There are no matching requirements from the Contractor.

This Second Amendment increases the amount of the second amended contract by \$20,000. It is being executed because, to comply with orders of the Forsyth County District Court, FCDSS will require more hours of Provider's services than was estimated at the time of the original contract and amendment one.

This Amendment is hereby effective upon its full execution. All other terms and conditions as set forth in the original agreement document shall remain in full force and effect for the duration of this agreement and are incorporated herein by reference as if fully set forth herein.
