

NC Medicaid Transformation (NC Managed Care)

Medicaid beneficiaries will transform from a fee-for-service health plan to a managed care plan effective November 1, 2019. Forsyth County Department of Social Services (FCDSS) will have approximately 35,000 beneficiaries enrolled in the managed care as of November 1, 2019. All Medicaid beneficiaries were mailed a notice starting June 28 alerting beneficiaries of their Medicaid status for "mandatory or exempt" for enrolling in NC Medicaid Managed.

Forsyth County Medicaid Beneficiaries with Mandatory Status

- Medicaid beneficiaries with a status of "mandatory" must select a Prepaid Health Plan (PHP) and Primary Care Provider (PCP) **before** September 16, 2019.
- Medicaid beneficiaries who do not select a PHP/PCP prior to September 16, 2019 **will automatically be enrolled to a PHP/PCP.**
- Beneficiaries deemed "mandatory" must enroll in one of **4** Prepaid Health Plans, WellCare, United HealthCare Community Plan, Healthy Blue, and AmeriHealth Caritas.
- Forsyth County Medicaid beneficiaries will begin using their PHPs effective November 1, 2019.

NC Medicaid Transformation (NC Medicaid Direct)

There are an estimated 18,000 Forsyth County Medicaid Beneficiaries who will remain NC Medicaid Direct (fee-for-service) due to the type of Medical services beneficiaries receive. These beneficiaries will not enroll with a Prepaid Health Plan

Forsyth County Medicaid Beneficiaries with Exempt or Excluded Status

- Beneficiaries who qualify for both Medicaid and Medicare (referred to as "dually eligible")
- All-Inclusive Care for the Elderly (PACE)
- Individuals whose income exceeds the Medicaid income limits and are able to meet spend down (deductible) limits.
- "Undocumented Immigrants" who qualify for emergency services
- Beneficiaries who are eligible for Presumptive Medicaid (Prenatal services only)
- Health Insurance Premium Payment members (HIPPP)
- Beneficiaries who get CAP/C and CAP/DA Services
- Innovation waiver services
- Family Planning Services (this is not full Medicaid)
- Beneficiaries receiving behavioral health services will have the option to enroll in NC Medicaid Managed Care or remain in NC Medicaid Direct
